

## Lakeshore Skating Club

### **Important - Club Rules**

Lakeshore Skating Club (LSC) welcomes you this skating season. In order to ensure that our partnerships at LSC are positive for all and out of respect for all coaches and skaters, we ask that you comply with the following rules at all times:

(Skaters, parents and coaches who register with Lakeshore Skating Club do so knowing and accepting the Club's rules).

- Be alert for other skaters at all times. Skaters who do not watch where they are going and are posing a danger to others will receive only one warning by any coach or executive member before being asked to leave the ice for the remainder of the session. Coaches are responsible for ensuring their students know and abide by these rules. This will be enforced even if a skater is in a lesson.
- Coaches should coach from the boards unless teaching choreography, please leave the corners and center ice for the skaters.
- The skater whose music is playing ALWAYS has the right of way and other skaters must move out of their way – coaches must inform their skaters!
- Spins should be practiced in the middle of the ice, not in the corners. Exception: During a skater's program spins may be done where choreographed. Space must be respected.
- Coaches must ensure that all guest fee's are paid before entering the ice surface.
- Coaches not registered at LSC must first obtain permission to teach on our ice.
- In compliance with arena rules, no food or drinks (other than water) is allowed in the ice surface.
- Kicking the ice or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. One warning by a coach or member of the Executive will be given – if repeated the skater will be asked to leave the ice for the remainder of the session.
- Skaters are reminded that games such as tag or follow the leader can be dangerous and are therefore not permitted.
- Coaches with skaters testing from outside the home club are required to ensure that test sheets, summary sheets and permission slips arrive to LSC the week before test day.
- No tests will be allowed or competition forms signed if there are any outstanding monies owed to either LSC or the coach.
- Excessive yelling or shouting will not be tolerated – there are other coaches and skaters to consider.
- Lutz corners are for lutz jumps only – please keep them clear!
- Skaters may only stay on the ice for the session they are registered for – late comers may not make up their ice time by staying extra time on the next session.
- Skaters and coaches are asked to clear the ice promptly at the end of each session – so that we can keep to our schedule. The Zamboni is not permitted to start movement on to the ice until all skaters and coaches are off.
- Coaches will not speak negatively of other coaches or skaters, regardless of personal opinions - be it on the ice or in the arena.
